

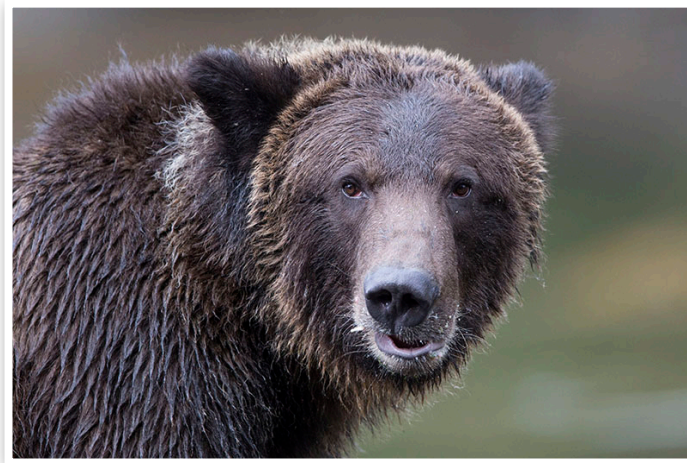
Festival of Bears 2018

Super bear-viewing with a focus on photography

Mark joins Wildlife Worldwide founder, Chris Breen, on the ever-popular Festival of Bears. For the 2018 festival, they will have exclusive use of Knight Inlet, which is a wonderful floating lodge in the heart of grizzly bear country. This is the perfect time to see the bears gorging on salmon in preparation for hibernation.

A glorious maze of wildlife-rich inlets and fjords dotted with islands, the region is the largest remaining coastal

temperate rainforest on Earth. As well as bears, there is a chance to see humpback and killer whales, bald eagles and a rare coastal sub-species of grey wolf, all against a beautiful backdrop of lush, ancient forest.

In brief
