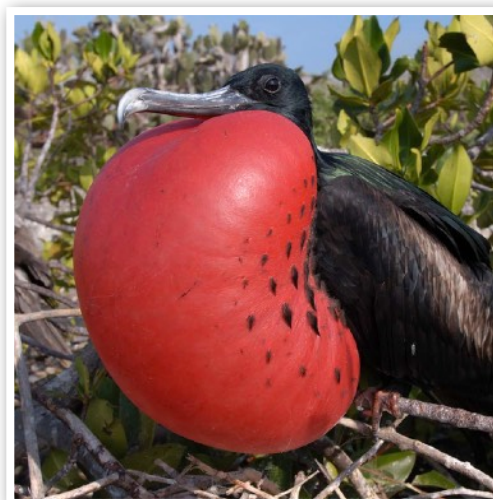
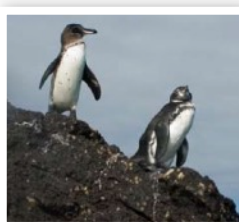


Galápagos Exclusive

Aboard the exclusively chartered 16-berth *MV Beluga* (bottom right), this new 11-night voyage to the Galápagos explores no fewer than 12 islands in the archipelago. There will be photographic opportunities aplenty, both above and below the waves. Species we hope to encounter include the blue-footed booby, magnificent frigatebird, the endemic Galápagos flightless cormorant, marine iguana, red-billed tropicbird, Galápagos penguin, lava lizard, land iguana, Galápagos sealion and the giant tortoise.
